## **FY07 House Labor-HHS-Education Bill**

According to an update issued by the Committee on Education Funding, House Republican leaders have postponed voting on the FY07 Labor-HHS-Education spending bill. Republican moderates and conservatives are at odds over spending levels and are unable to come to an agreement. Reportedly, the bill may not go to the floor until after the November elections, much to the dismay of Chairman Lewis, who had anticipated moving all 11 FY07 spending bills through the House by the July 4<sup>th</sup> recess. The House appropriations full committee has filed its report, which is expected to be available next week.
